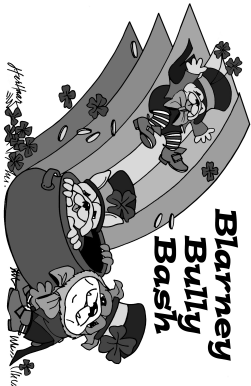

ENTRY FEES

First entry of a dog in conformation each show - \$30.00.

Sweeps (French bulldogs only) – free!

Junior Showmanship (Sun Bulldog show only, handler must handle a Bulldog) – free!

TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of Official AKC entry forms are not acceptable.

NO ENTRY shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.

Fees include the \$3.00 AKC EVENT SERVICE FEE AND A RECORDING FEE of \$.50 on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, or the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on each entry of a dog in Rally. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes or special attractions.) These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

The French Bulldog Club of America and the Bulldog Club of America assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or any of their dogs or property. All these clubs further assume no responsibility for injury to children. PARENTS & GUARDIANS MUST KEEP THEIR CHILDREN UNDER CONTROL ON THE SHOW GROUNDS. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children while on the show grounds.

There will be a \$25.00 Processing Fee for all checks returned for insufficient funds.

Admission to the show is free, exhibitors are advised to bring their own chairs.

Rings will be indoors.

NO FIREARMS are allowed within the show site limits.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior Class - For boys and girls at least 9 years & under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. **Novice Intermediate Class** - For boys and girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class - For boys and girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. **Open Junior Class** - For boys and girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. **Open Intermediate Class** - For boys and girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. **Open Senior Class** - For boys and girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. **Master Class** - For Boys & Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won ten First Place wins in open class, with competition present, to be eligible to enter the limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be Nov 1-October 31 of the following year. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed.

AKC Junior Handler Numbers are required for entry and may be obtained by phone (919) 816-3776 or email tbh@akc.org. Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information for the entry in Junior Showmanship to be accepted. Bitches in season are NOT eligible at specialty shows. Dog must be of the breed for which the show is held.

According to AKC rules, there must be competition in order for Best Junior Handler to be awarded. A dog other than the one entered may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made with the Show Secretary of Superintendent at least 1/2 hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship classes at the show. The winner of a third First Place in each Novice class shall automatically become eligible to enter in the Open Class at this show, provided that there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in that Open Class.
