### ROBERTS CENTRE HOUSEKEEPING RESPONSIBILITIES FOR MEMBERS

1. All dogs left unattended in hotel guest rooms must be crated.
2. French Bulldog Club of America will provide sheets of plastic to place under the crates. Up to four dogs will be permitted per room.
3. Housekeepers will not have to service rooms in which dogs are loose and unattended. Moreover, they will be required to report this rule violation to hotel management. A pet deposit of \$50 will be charged for each room in which a dog is housed per stay. Individual room occupants will be assessed for any damage or destruction to their room.
4. Dogs will be bathed in designated areas for dog washing. There will be no grooming of dogs in hotel rooms and no hotel towels will be used for this purpose.
5. French Bulldog Club of America will assign a liaison to meet daily with the Head of Housekeeping and hotel management to assure that all of its members are complying with hotel rules. Any offenders will be asked to leave the hotel immediately.
6. Dogs will not be permitted in any of the hotel recreation areas, including the swimming pools, and any other areas to be stipulated as “non-dog” locations.
7. Dogs will not be permitted in food and beverage outlets, with the exception of those assisting the disabled.
8. French Bulldog Club of America will work with hotel management to establish a sufficient number of dog walking/exercising areas for all French Bulldog Club of America and management will create a site map with the designated areas clearly marked. These areas will also be staked and marked with colored tape so it is evident where they are located.
9. The hotel will provide trash receptacles in the designated exercised areas for deposit of waste.
10. French Bulldog Club of America will provide plastic bags and appropriate scoops, etc. for the collection of waste.
11. Pick up and removal of waste will be the responsibility of each dog owner/handler.
12. French Bulldog Club of America will appoint a Grounds Committee to continuously monitor all exercise areas to assure that members comply with the rules.
13. No Soft Sided Crates in Royal Canin Ring & Eukanuba Field.
14. Convention Centre doors must be closed during event hours for safety of the dogs. Royal Canin Ring & Eukanuba Field /Roberts Centre/Holiday Inn will take no responsibility to insure doors remain closed.
15. No dogs may be left/crated in Royal Canin Ring & Eukanuba Field overnight.

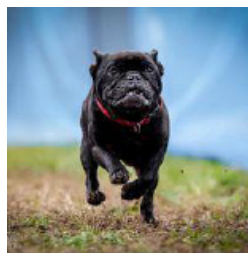

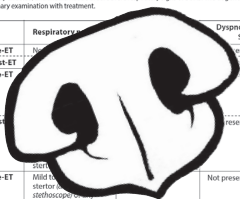

**BOAS Functional Grading**

- Grade 0** Clinically unaffected. Free of respiratory signs; annual health check is suggested if the dog is under 2 years old.
- Grade I** Clinically unaffected. Mild respiratory signs of BOAS but does not affect exercise performance. Annual health check is suggested if the dog is under 2 years old.
- Grade II** Clinically affected. The dog has a clinically relevant respiratory signs and requires management, including weight loss and/or surgical intervention.
- Grade III** Clinically affected, and should not be bred. Severe respiratory signs of BOAS. The dog should have a thorough veterinary examination with treatment.

**All Dogs Present** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

**Class Cash Prizes** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Event Secretaries' Office advised at once. The Event Secretaries and Show-Giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

**No gasoline or diesel generators** are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
